

DIG THE FALLS

Gleasmans Falls - Lowville

A nice long hike, with plenty to see along the way!

Gleasmans Falls - Lowville

Location: Lowville, Watson Town

Park/Area: Independence River Wild Forest

Parking: 43.80719, -75.27520

Trailhead: 43.80839, -75.27599

Trail Name/Reference to: Beach Mill Pond Trail

Landmark:

Beach Mill Pond and then, Second Creek: 43.800722, -75.235621

Stream/River/Watershed: Independence River

Waterfall Reference Point: 43.79968 -75.23311

Height of Falls/Type: 50 ft total, series of cascades, highest being 10 ft

Level of Difficulty/Hiking Distance: 6.6 Round Trip

Comments/Notes:

Gleasmans Falls is not on the trailhead sign

From the trailhead, head south downhill and cross a bridge over Burnt Creek, reaching the trail register

Continue across Burnt Creek, following yellow trail markers.

About 1 mile, reach a beaver pond, bog bridge, and a footbridge.

At 2.5 miles reach the bridge over Second Creek

Reach gorge at 2.9 miles near a campsite

Highest falls at 3.1 miles.

Directions: From the intersection of Hwy 12 and Stowe St and River St (CR 26), in Lowville, take River St East for .7 miles. This is the intersection with East State St. Continue straight ahead here, still heading east. The road name changed from River St to Number Four Rd.

Drive 6.3 miles. Turn right onto Losom Rd and drive .4 miles. Turn right onto McPhilly Rd and drive 2.9 miles. Turn left onto Beach Mill Rd and drive 3 miles to its end at the Beach Mill Pond Parking Trail head.
